

First Aid Training During Winter Lockdown

Following the government announcement on Saturday evening (31 October), we continually review how best to meet our customers' training needs. We can confirm that most of our training courses scheduled during winter lockdown will continue as planned.

Training is permitted during lockdown, provided it is run in a COVID secure manner, class sizes are not affected by the rule of six.

Our new safety measures

We are implementing the following measures to keep your delegates and our employees safe:

- If a delegate has any of the symptoms of COVID-19 (e.g. new persistent cough, high temperature, loss or change to sense of smell or taste) they must not attend training
- Daily temperature check using an infra-red thermometer
- All delegates and employees will be required to wear a face-covering on entry to and while moving around our building. Delegates may remove their face-covering when seated for training and the trainer will remove theirs to present the course.
- Course sizes have been reduced to accommodate social distancing
- There is hand sanitisation available and regular hand-washing protocols in place
- We maintain our rigorous manikin cleaning protocols
- Each candidate will be provided a Training pack including bandages, gloves & disposable face mask for relevant practical sessions.
- Tea & coffee is still available during training. We provide disposable plastic cups & holders but candidates are welcome to bring their own cups/flasks if preferred.
