

Qualitative Face Fit Testing – Initial Test Screening

Client Information

1. The Qualitative testing allows **only** for half face masks to be tested (including FFP 1, 2 & 3 disposable masks) – full face masks require Quantitative testing (ROHS do not provide Quantitative screening).
2. Must be at least half a days' worth of work due to the solution being used and waste
3. The Face fit Testing takes around 20 minutes per employee
4. Any employee undertaking the face fit testing must not eat, drink (except water), smoke, vape or have chewing gum for 30 minutes prior to the test.
5. Employees will need to bring their FFP or half face mask with canister (if applicable) with them to the appointment
6. Employees must be clean shaven and have no more than 24 hour hair growth (Shaving the morning of the test is ideal)
7. Employees will need ensure they bring any prescription glasses or eyewear with them to the appointment
8. Long hair must be tied back
9. Testing may not be suitable for people who have musculoskeletal issues (neck and back) as the testing requires movements to be made (i.e. looking up and downs, side to side and bending over)
10. If a candidate fails the test they must wait 45 minutes before retesting. Candidates must not eat, drink smoke, vape or chew gum during this time.
11. Certificates are for the mask that is tested and only that mask, model and size.
